PUBLIC WORKS REPORT February 2025

Streets:

- Plowed and salted streets, garage parking lot, village hall parking lot and East Avenue property – shoveled and salted sidewalks around village hall
- Removed piles of snow on sidewalk – north of Main Street and pushed back snow into park on south side of Main Street
- Removed and pushed back piles of snow at intersections of streets, dead ends of Pallister Avenue and Woodward Avenue – snow along Pallister Avenue from High Street to dead end – east and west sides, also East Avenue – between Coleman Road and High Street – east and west sides
- Cleared all sidewalks in the village with snowblower
- Had a load of salt delivered

Water:

- THM and HAA water testing at 1889 Quaker Road – took samples and had them sent out to be tested
- Backflow device inspection at 1890 Pallister Avenue – house sold
- Met with Halstead Plumbing – backflow device at old village hall – old, galvanized pipes – next day it was installed
- Dig Request at 1692 Quaker Road – water main and service was located and marked in blue paint

Equipment:

- Readied 2012 dump truck for pick up from Hartland
- Washed both trucks and tractors – rinsed salter inside and out

Parks:

- Emptied garbage cans in both parks – weekly
- Replaced damaged (ripped from high winds) flag in village park

Other:

- Board Meeting
- Budget meeting
- Wrote monthly reports
- Hung awards up at village hall
- Cut sign posts, installed rubber bases, and attached signs for reserved parking at village hall parking lot
- Picked up ice melt at Home Depot and Clydes
- Dropped off recycling cart at 1611 Quaker Road and garbage cart at 1730 East Avenue

- Worked on budget – got pricing from contractors for paving Pallister Avenue and filling street cracks – Pricing on two tractors B2601 and L4060 series – pricing of new tractors and trade in value and price on DPW garage parking lot
- Replaced flag at village hall – ripped from high winds
