PUBLIC WORKS REPORT June 2025

Streets:

- Watered plants along Main Street
- Installed side panels and mess top to dump truck – hooked up chipper and went around chipping brush
- Sprayed for weeds along sidewalk – north side of Main Street
- Mowed ditches, roadsides, right of ways and around garage area
- Went around village weeding and spraying for weeds
- Trimmed vines and bushes at corner of Church Street and Quaker Road
- Filled in potholes with cold patch
- Hooked up brush hog and brush hogged ditch off Fels Road

Water:

- Dig request at 1721 and 1695 Quaker Road – replacing power poles – located and marked water
- 1645 Quaker Road – got a call that water was leaking from shut off on basement – went there and fixed leak
- Backflow inspection at 1707 Pallister Avenue – did not have device – owner will call when installed
- Read water meters for the quarter

Equipment:

- Changed belt on chipper
- Changed oil and filter on B2601 tractor
- Washed both trucks and tractors
- Took brush hog off tractor
- Changed transmission and hydraulic oil and filters on B2601 tractor
- Changed blades on mower deck

Parks:

- Mowed and weeded in both parks
- Picked up more mulch and finished mulching parks
- Emptied garbage cans in both parks – weekly
- Trimmed bushes around gazebo in village park
- Replaced rotten rails and stained fence at lake park
- Trimmed branches in village park
- Fixed hose bib in village park

Other:

- Board meeting
- Wrote monthly reports

- Installed bike rack on edge of village hall pavement
- Weeded around garage area and sprayed for weeds
- Cover office at village hall
- Went to Shelby Stone to pick up cold patch
- Trimmed back branches and vines along fence at DPW garage
- DPW garage lost power – line down between garage power pole and Woodward Avenue – tree company cut trees for path and National Grid installed new line
