PUBLIC WORKS REPORT May 2025

Streets:

- Mowed roadsides, right of ways and along ditches
- 8700 High Street – pat down topsoil, leveled off and seeded where water leak was repaired
- Niagara County Highway Department repaired sink hole due to clay drainpipe collapse on Quaker Road across from High Street
- Planted flowers in barrels and set along Main Street
- Went around village and weeded around hydrants, signs and intersections

Water:

- THM and HAA water sampling – took water samples from 1889 Quaker Road to Niagara Falls lab to be tested
- Backflow inspection at 1639 Quaker Road
- Attended New York Rural Water Associations Conference
- Dig request at 1669 Quaker Road, 1885 and 1890 Pallister Avenue – located water and marked with blue flags and paint

Equipment:

- Changed blades on mower deck and cleaned deck
- Had salter taken off dump truck – help from Town Water Department and installed back tail gate onto dump body
- Washed both trucks and tractors

Parks:

- Mowed and weeded in both parks
- Raked both parks from mowing
- Trimmed plants around gazebo at lake park
- Filled in spots with topsoil in village park from plowing snow at village hall into park
- Emptied garbage cans in both parks – weekly
- Planted flowers and mulched in village park
- Put together picnic tables and placed in pavilion at village park

Other:

- Wrote monthly reports
- Work session
- Board meeting

- Mahars installed driveway to garage from Woodward Avenue and right of way at end of Woodward Avenue
- Picked up load of topsoil and mulch
- Put together park benches and placed in front of village hall also set out flower barrels
- Added more topsoil in flag pole area at village hall – planted flowers and mulched
