PUBLIC WORKS REPORT July 2025

Streets:

- Watered plants along Main Street
- Mowed roadsides, ditches, around garage area and right of ways
- Hooked up chipper to dump truck – chipped brush
- Midland crack filled Main Street, East Avenue and High Street
- Weeded around village

Water:

- Re-read meter at 1880 Quaker Road (high usage) owners found a toilet running
- Dig request at 8677 Church Street – located and marked water

Equipment:

- Changed belt on chipper
- Changed oil and filter on B2601 tractor
- Washed both trucks and tractors
- Took brush hog off tractor
- Changed transmission and hydraulic oil and filters on B2601 tractor
- Changed blades on mower deck

Parks:

- Mowed and weeded in both parks
- Watered plants in village park
- Emptied garbage cans in both parks – weekly
- Scraped light posts and painted in front of the gazebo in village park
- Sprayed for weeds at lake park
- Trimmed low branches on large tree in village park
- Reinforced railing on steps at gazebo in village park

Other:

- Board meeting
- Wrote monthly reports
- Changed flag at village hall
- Monroe Extinguisher inspected extinguishers at village hall and DPW garage
- Old shed removed behind village hall – removed stone, filled in with topsoil and seeded
- Cleaned windows on the outside of village hall
- Trimmed branches along driveway going into DPW garage
- NAPA for parts

- **Changed filters in heating and cooling units at village hall and removed outside covers and rinsed off condenser units**

- **Weeded around garage area and sprayed for weeds**
