Streets:

- Watered plants along Main Street
- Mowed roadsides, ditches, around garage area and right of ways
- Checked on County Highway Department – repairing storm drain at Quaker Road and Coleman Road
- Weeded both sides of stone extension of Woodward Avenue – dead end

Water:

- Five dig requests – three were clear, located and marked water for other two
- Checked water service in front of 1725 Quaker Road – National Grid installing anchor cable to pole
- Got a call from 8692 Coleman Road (possible water leak) – green patch of grass by curb box – located curb box, listened to service – no leak
- Back flow inspection at 1768 Pallister Avenue – house selling
- Dropped off bottles and paperwork for lead testing at 8701 and 8706 High Street – this completes ten samples that had to be taken – took water samples to Niagara Falls to be tested
- Read water meters for the quarter

Equipment:

- Nothing to report at time

Parks:

- Mowed and weeded in both parks
- Emptied garbage cans in both parks – weekly
- Decorated village park for Homecoming and Halloween

Other:

- Moved chairs and tables from board room – carpet being cleaned
- Wire brushed gas pipe and painted grey – south side of village hall
